

FENCE BUILDING STEPS

Even if you've never erected a fence before, using WARATAH® products makes it easy to finish with a professional job. Here are some of the basic steps to build a good fence.



1 Determine best site for new fence unless it's a boundary and prepare line and grade if necessary. Consider site contours, erosion and soil type.



2 Erect end assemblies — they are critical to building a good fence.



3 Strain a sight wire close to the ground and lay posts at pre-determined spacing by 'stepping out' along the fence line. A straight fence line minimises pressure points.



4 Drive Waratah posts with a GalStar or pneumatic post driver - depth and position as per your fence line.



5 Attach wire to one end assembly and strain the wire to the other end assembly using a Wedgelock® clamp and/or Wizard® wire strainer, check tension with Tenser Sensor®, then tie off.



6 Attach wire to posts using Star® Post Clips.
